ECLS Dress Code

The intent of the dress code is to establish and maintain an inclusive school environment, conducive to learning. By maintaining basic guidelines and standards, more of each student's cognitive energy can go toward new academic challenges and social emotional growth, rather than their daily outfit choices. We think that is a good thing!

Little Jags and Prekindergarten

Students in our Little Jags and our prekindergarten programs are not required to wear uniforms. All Little Jags and prekindergarten students are encouraged to wear play clothes.

Shirts/Sweatshirts/Sweaters/Fleeces

- Students may wear any blue, white, or gray Wellington-branded shirt/sweatshirt/sweater/ fleece.
- All non-Wellington sweatshirts/hoodies/ sweaters/fleece need to be solid color in navy, white, or gray. Polos can be navy, white, or gray. Small non-Wellington clothing brand logos are permitted. T-shirts must be navy.

Footwear

- Footwear must be reasonably clean and in good repair. No lights, characters, wheels, or other additions that might become a distraction or safety concern in the classroom.
- Athletic shoes should grip feet and allow for easy movement.
- Shoes made primarily of plastic or rubber (i.e. crocs, soccer slides, flip flops, etc.) are not permitted. No boots are permitted.

Shorts

- Tan or navy, no cargo or denim
- Must be fingertip to mid-thigh in length

Jumper/Skirts/Skorts

- MacEwen plaid*, tan, or navy skirt or skort.
- Jumper may be MacEwen plaid*, tan, or navy.
- White/blue/gray shorts/tights/legging/jeggings (not sweatpants) should be worn under skirts.

Pants

- Tan or navy, no cargo or denim
- Jeggings/leggings are not permitted unless under a skirt/skort.

Dress Down

- Any graphics or messaging must be school appropriate.
- During Jag Fridays, students may dress down or wear the school dress code.

General Policies

- Student clothing must fit properly.
- Tops must cover shoulders, collarbone, and midriff.
- Clothing must be free of rips and tears.
- Hats are not permitted.
- Any jewelry/watch will need to stay on the body and should not be distracting to the student or peers.
- The following items available at the athletics Sideline Store are NOT compliant: all shorts, pants, leggings, compression items, footwear, and wearable blanket.
- At times, students will be asked to wear "special event" dress code. This includes a white polo and khaki bottoms.
