Transportation 2024-2025 - A Guide for Parents

The Wellington School currently offers transportation at a minimal fee for students in grades K-12. The cost for one-way transportation is \$480 per child per semester and round trip is \$630 per child per semester. Bus service is also available daily at a rate of \$6 each way. Please know that all stops are subject to change at any time based on rider usage, and bus rates are also subject to change.

Local school districts that bus to Wellington:

- **Bexley: 614-231-7611** (grades K-12) Parents will need to complete a [transportation request form](#). This form, along with the Emergency Medical Authorization form, will need to be filled out and sent to the Board of Education Office.
- **Columbus: 614-365-5074** (grades K-12) Parents will need to complete a [Charter & Non-Public Request for Transportation](#). It is recommended that you do this ASAP. Route information is emailed directly to the parents by Columbus City Schools. Parents are encouraged to sign up for [BusBulletin](#) to receive notifications directly from CCS Transportation.
- **Dublin: 614-764-5926** (grades K-12) Parent will need to complete the [Charter School/Non Public Transportation Request](#). The driver will contact families. Please call the number listed here if you have not been contacted.
- **Gahanna-Jefferson: 614-751-7581** (grades K-12) Parents with a student residing in this district may seek transportation information or payment in lieu of transportation by submitting a request [here](#).
- **Hilliard: 614-921-4700** (grades K-12) Parents will need to complete a private-school transportation request, which can be found [here](#). The driver will contact families. Please call the number listed here if you have not been contacted.
- **Upper Arlington: 614-487-6477** (grades K-8) Parents will need to complete a [transportation request form](#). Upper Arlington does not provide bus service to students in grades 9-12.

Some local school districts will offer reimbursement for bus service if they do not provide busing to The Wellington School. Families are encouraged to contact their local school district transportation office. The reimbursement amount is determined by the State of Ohio and checks are typically issued in August or September of the following school year.
